Gun tying and safety measures

All firearms that fire fixed ammunition should be checked, cleared, and tied in an inoperable position. This rule is not negotiable. Dealers are responsible for tying their firearms.

Safety Rules

Be careful, use common sense, and always obey the following rules:

- NEVER load any firearm in the show for any reason.
- Treat all guns as if they were loaded.
- Never point a gun at anything you are not willing to destroy.
- Keep your finger off the trigger.

General

Obey all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules, ordinances, and regulations. If you have any questions about these laws, consult your attorney for advice. Show exhibitors are expected to make only factual representations regarding the quality and authenticity of the items displayed and sold at the show.

Record Keeping and Identification

No sign(s) or written notice may be displayed by the dealer or seller that states that any firearm offered for sale are part of a private collection and are not subject to record-keeping, identification, and or background checks. Any non-licensed seller of firearms must positively determine identification, residency, and age of buyer by a governmental agency-issued ID. Sales of a handgun can only be to a Texas resident 21 years of age or older. Sales of rifles and shotguns can only be made to a person 18 years of age or older.

Merchandise

- **Guns** – we primarily want dealers who sell guns and gun-related items.
- **Ammunition** – Powder, and primers are allowed, all ammunition must be in sealed packages.
- **Jewelry** – Jewelry is allowed (limited vendors) in the hallway ONLY.
- **Art & Books** – Preferred gun-related (Gun, Hunting, Wildlife, Western, American Indian or Military), General items are limited - arts and crafts, handicrafts, beadwork, quilts, dolls ETC will be allowed in the halls or outside only; not in the main Gun show Room. Books can not contain adult and or sexually related subjects (limited vendors) in the hallway ONLY.

Cancellations, Refunds, Rollovers

We do NOT want vacant/empty tables. Call us at 936-258-6630 or email awilson@daytontx.org you have a problem. There are absolutely no excuses for not contacting us. Rollovers to next year's show are allowed but are subject to the rules. Refunds are available on a case-by-case basis. **Unclaimed table(s) will be forfeited at 8:45 a.m. Saturday, June 18, 2022**, unless you have made prior arrangements for late arrival. If your table has been forfeited we are not responsible for any loss of profit, sales, expenses, and or any other related damages.

Reservation

You may reserve the same table for the next show when you check in. We highly encourage reserving your space for the show (3rd weekend of every June) at the time of check-in or before the end of the current show.
